



BEGINNING POTTERY WORKSHOP

For this class, we will work a Cone Five Clay, paid for out of your class registration deposit (\$20.00 which gives you a lot of clay). The clay we use is fairly smooth.

Materials and tools needed

Below is a list of materials and tools you will need. If you are resourceful, much of these items you can find around your house.

The bold printed items will be provided for work in class.

- **Plywood board, at least 18" square**
- **A piece of canvas or heavy muslin, about a yard's worth**
- An old butter knife.
- A couple of plastic cups or the equivalent for water
- Plastic bowls (Cool Whip containers or the likes) for water
- A general-purpose rag, like a dishrag
- Cloth for covering clay. You will need to bring your own for taking your project home to work on if you can't complete in class.
- Plastic for covering, such as a trash bag, or smaller, depending on the size of your project.
- Newspaper, paper towels, A few sheets will do.
- Bowl to use as a form. Any size.
- **Pottery working tools.** You will use ours in class then decide which you would like to buy for yourself.
- These are not expensive and ready-made kits can be purchased from craft stores.
- Included are a needle tool, a wooden knife, trimming tools and a cutting wire. However, you can use other things for some of these such as dental floss and old credit cards and popsicle sticks.
- Bring a Lazy Susan, if you have one, a spray bottle, an old toothbrush, old forks, or anything you think would make a good texture or design.

On the day of the workshop feel free to bring lunch and drinks for yourself. There is always Dusty Buns across the street.
